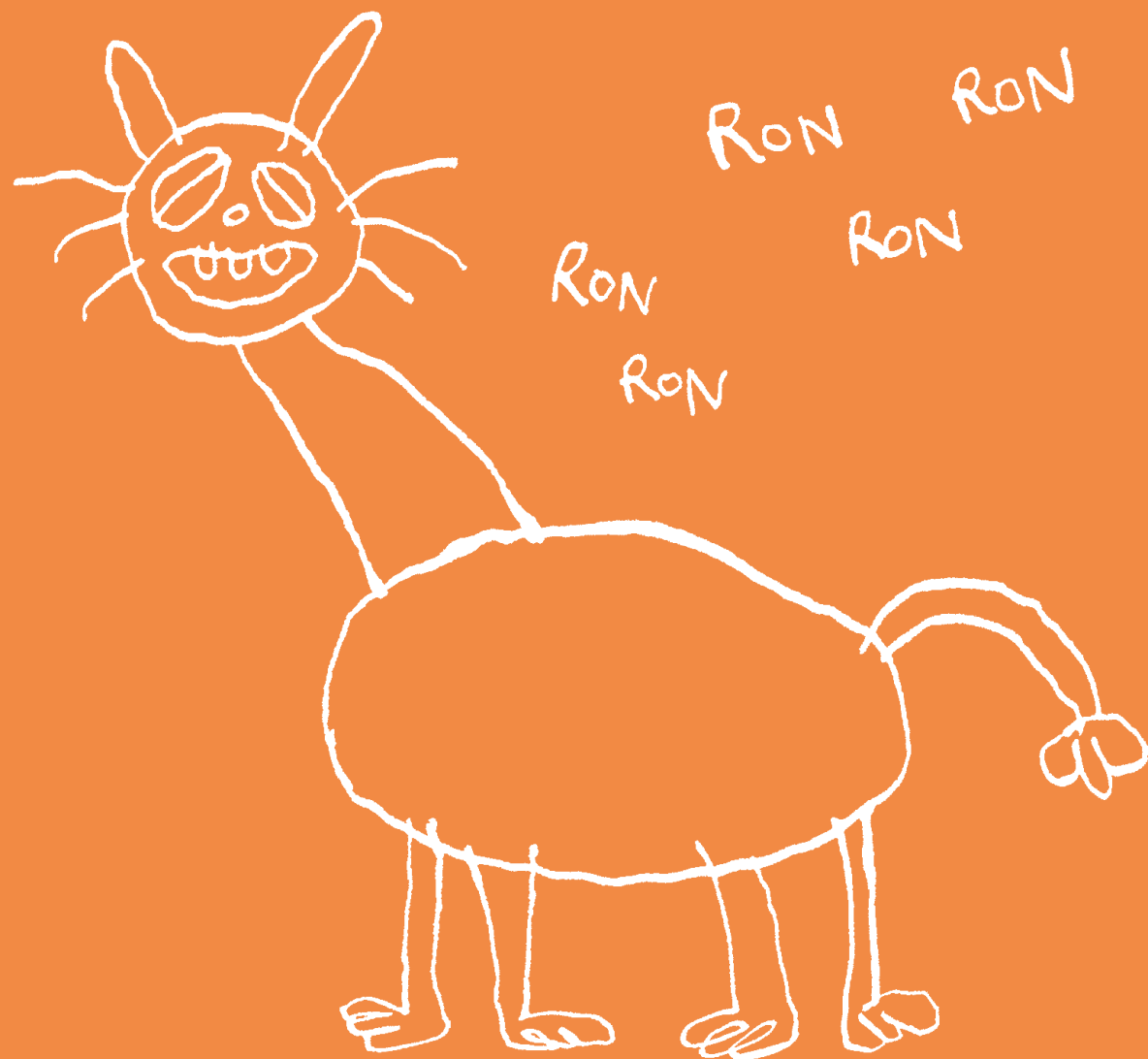


FIGURE 1: GRABUGE

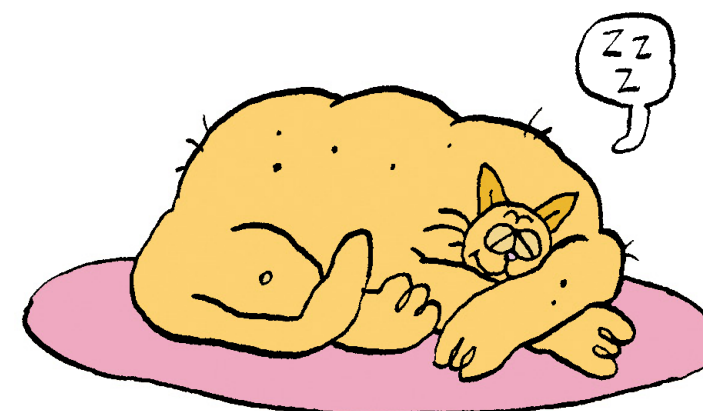
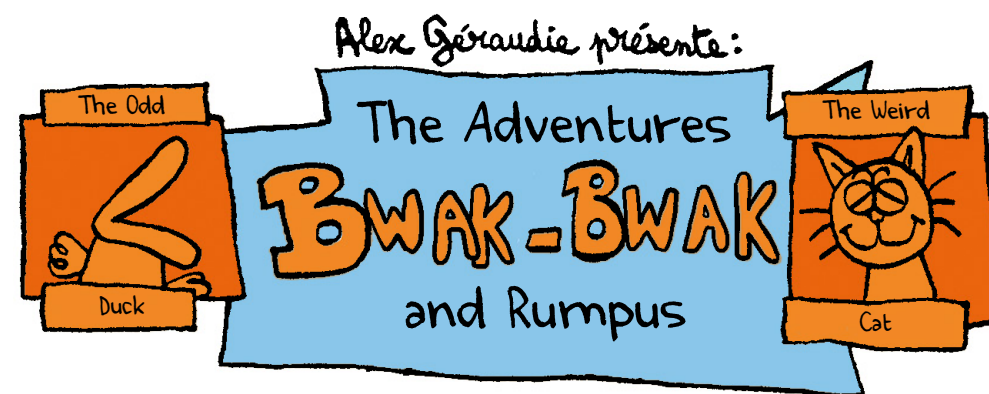
FIGURE 2: BOIN-BOIN

pourtant omniprésent.e!

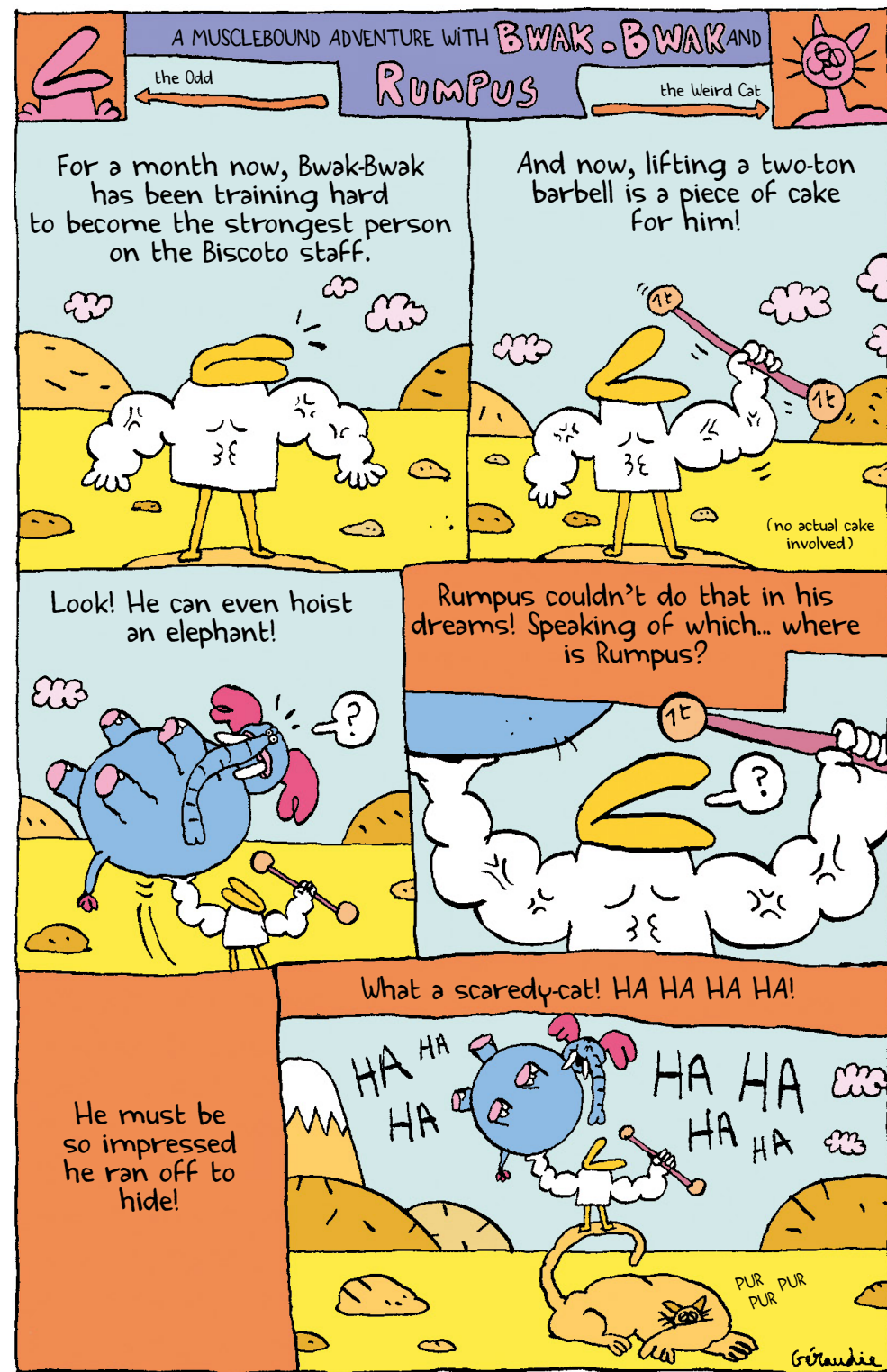
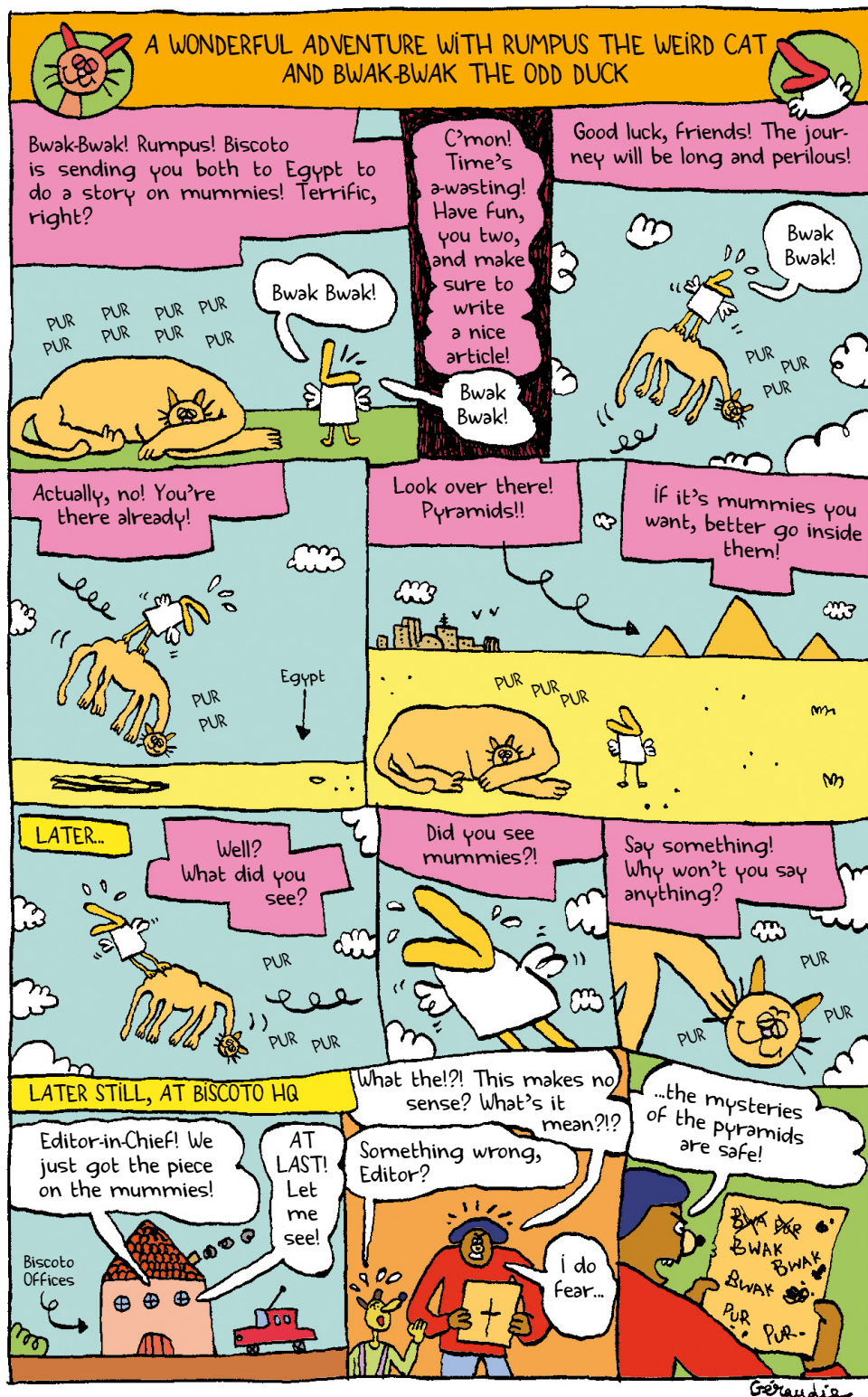
Il me semble donc que le titre de ce livre devrait

et du narrateur (ou de la narratrice)"!

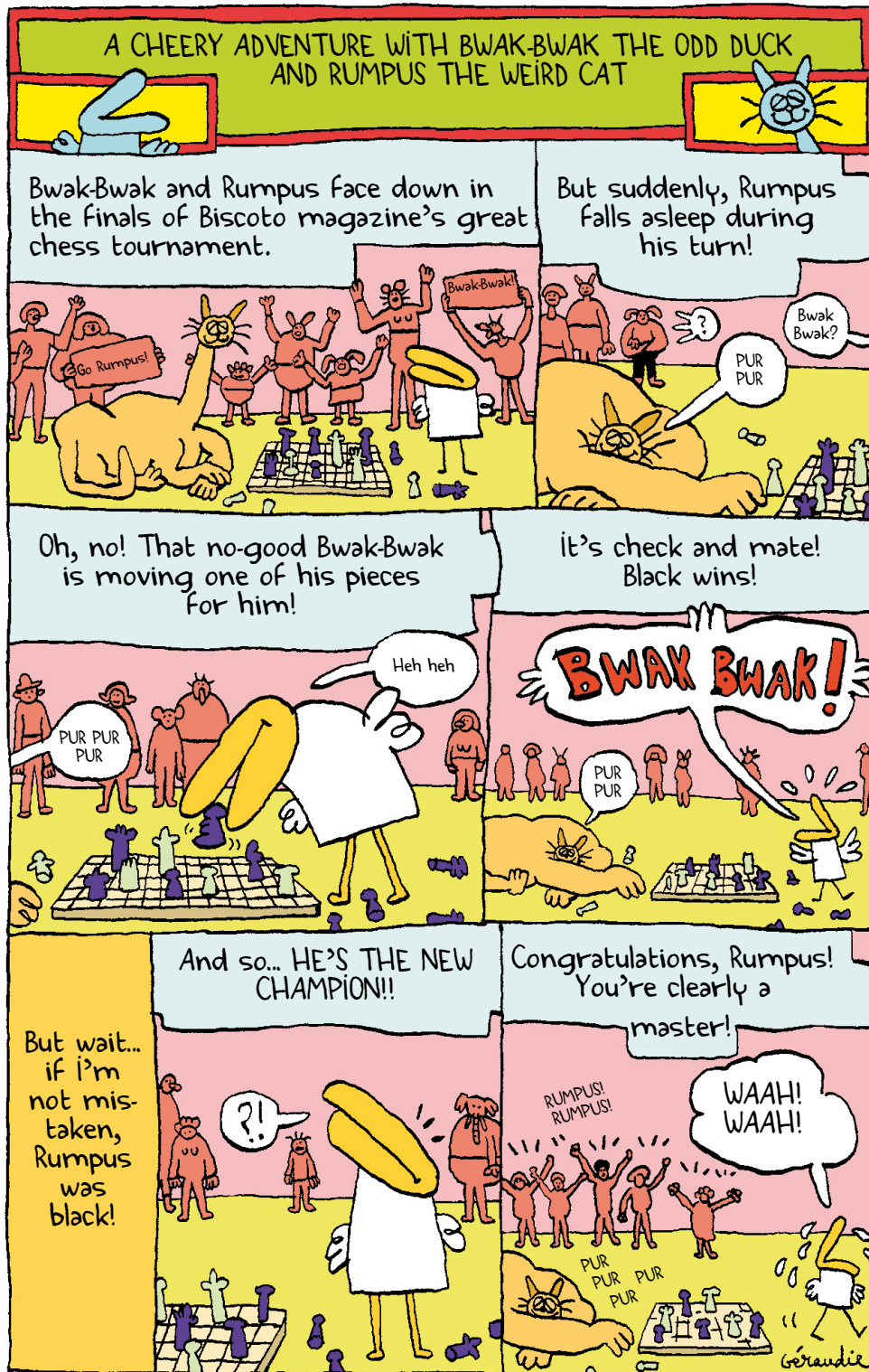
Enfin moi je dis ça... Vous imaginez Boin-Boin

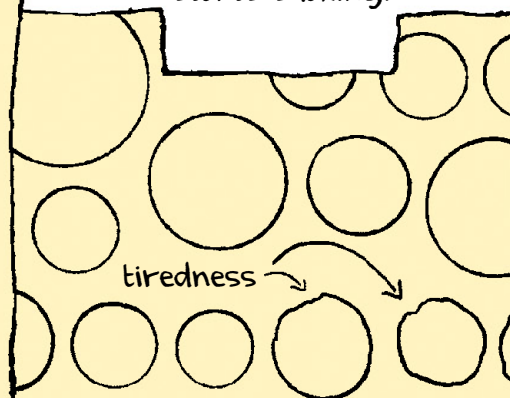




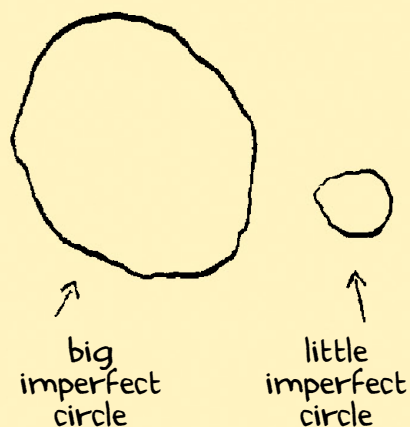
if you can't do it, never fear!

starts shaking.



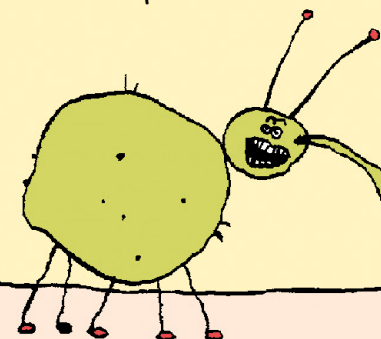
Your lines will get shakier

circles.



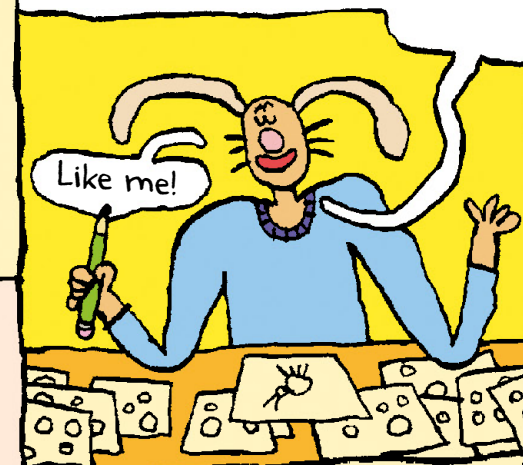
When you've reached that point,
