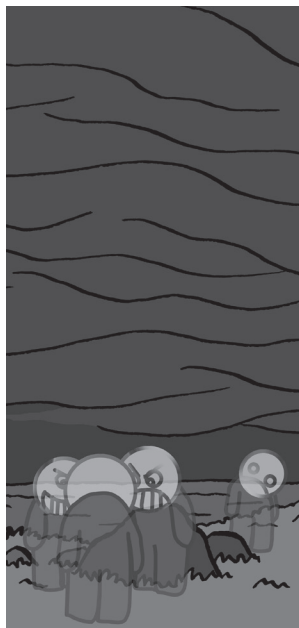

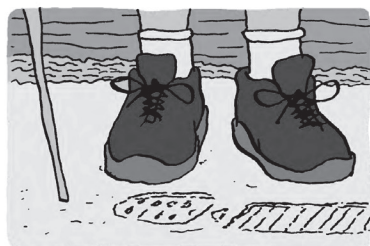
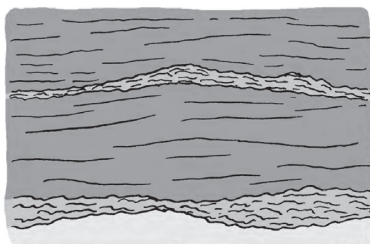
### The Author

Robin Cousin was born in 1984. As a boy he used to write screenplays he would then adapt as radio plays, comic books and home movies, with the help of his cousins and his play-doh. After trying out applied art and interior design, he ended up choosing comics. Comics are a very complete medium: a bit of drawing, a bit of writing, a bit of stage direction, a bit of acting. After five years at the Fine Arts school of Angoulême, he even wrote his dissertation about them.

Later on he founded Les Machines editions and co-organised the F.OFF in Angoulême. Published in 2013 and winner of the Scientific Fiction Prize in 2015, *The Invisible Researcher* is a love-letter to scientific research and the poetic game it holds on the world.

Can computers imitate human beings? How much power are we willing to give to the machines? These are the questions that keep him awake at night.
